Join your colleagues for this exhibit that features remarkable panel displays with large, compelling photos, two interactive kiosks, and five companion exhibit cases. It’s a blend of information, research, history, and technology.

The Allen Library was honored as the host for the exhibit, and chapter members from Cleveland Public Library collaborated on materials, which are available at the exhibit. The exhibit is easy to view, with large photos, text, and remarkable quotations that define each panel. The large photos are courtesy of some of the nation’s treasured archives—universities (such as Columbia University, Johns Hopkins University), the New York Public Library, and the manuscript, prints & photo division of the Library of Congress.

Step Back Into Time....

Besides enjoying the NLM exhibit, our chapter will have the exclusive use of three rooms directly adjacent to the main reading room of the Allen Library. Leather chairs and sofas beckon you to sit awhile amidst book-lined cases and oriental rugs....a huge fireplace and chandelier...private restroom, and fabulous food from Celebrations Catering. Treat yourself to a pre-holiday boost in these spaces, greet new friends, and catch up with colleagues!

Also open for us will be the Dittrick Medical History Center archive, as library staff introduces us to this distinguished collection of rare books (14th – 20th century), artifacts, archives (Darwin letters), and images. Part of the 75,000-item artifact collection is also showcased in the Millikin Room, one of the three rooms that we'll have for the evening. There will be ample time to view the NLM exhibit and tour the Dittrick collection—as well as relax in the private rooms.

Treat yourself to a quiet spot of luxury, an easy-to-view special exhibit, and superb food. Menu preview: seared ahi tuna, martinis, grilled flank steak strips, dim sum pastry pockets, sesame noodle salad with vegetables...and of course, dessert!
