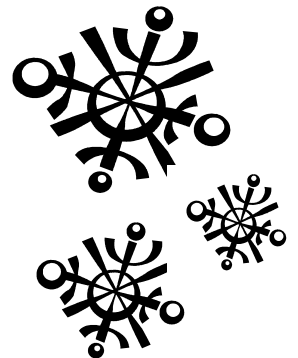

I-90 E, or I 71 N (becomes 1-90 E); also I480 E -> 176 N (Jennings Freeway)
Exit #172A, East 9th St., towards downtown

From South or Southeast or Akron, via I-77 N:

Exit #162B, East 14th St., towards E 22nd
Merge onto E. 14th, turn Left on Prospect, turn Right on E. 9th St.
(Choose from parking options below)

Parking Options/Traveling North on E. 9th Street

- 1) Cross Superior, turn Left onto Rockwell (Rockwell Garage, behind the bank)
- 2) Cross Superior, turn Right onto Rockwell (garage next to St. John's Cathedral, or One Cleveland on north side of Rockwell)
- 3) Turn left on Superior (BP garage across from the Cleveland Public Library)
