**John Cotton Dana Award**: Granted to an information professional to recognize a lifetime of achievement as well as beyond exceptional service to special librarianship.

**Fellow of SLA** : Presented to an SLA member to recognize leadership in their career as an information professional. Fellowship is bestowed on mid-career SLA members in recognition of past, present and future service to the Association and the profession.
