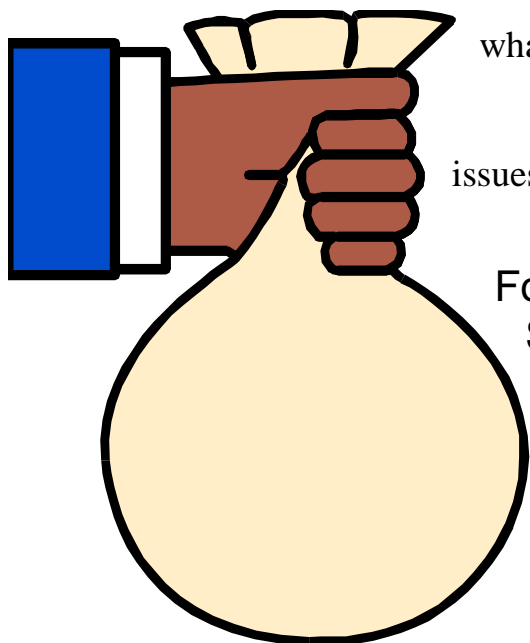


Georgia Chapter of the Special Libraries Association presents:
