From the parking deck, walk back down the hill, past the Visitor entrance and turn right at the first street so that you are walking past the Rich building. Continue over the bridge, turn right and continue walking until you see the entrance of the Woodruff Library. Sign in at the Security Desk and proceed to the Jones Room on the 3rd floor.
