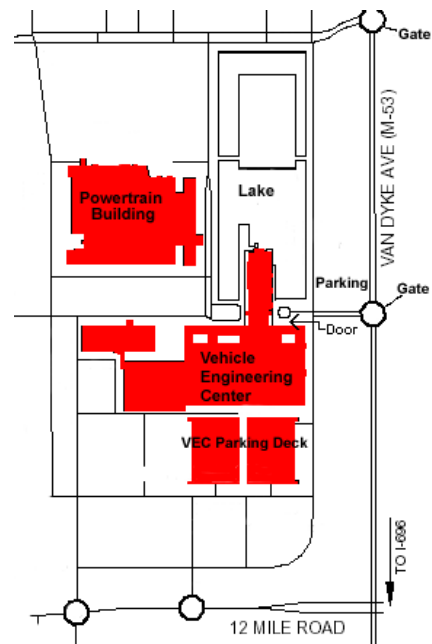
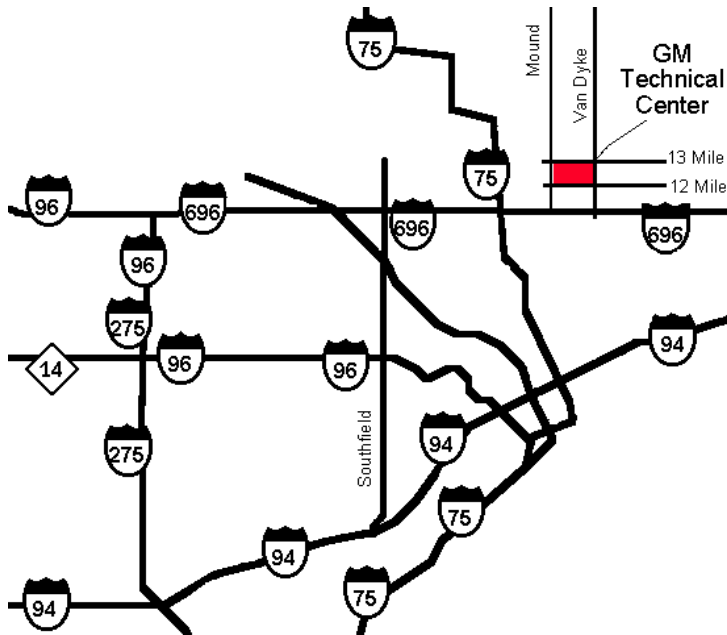
From the West (Dearborn, Ann Arbor, Livonia): Take I-275 or the Southfield Fwy north to I-696 east. Exit at Van Dyke and turn north (left).

From the East (Clinton Twp, St. Clair Shores): Take I-94 to I-696 west. Exit at Van Dyke and turn north (right).

From the North (Pontiac, Rochester, Flint): Take I-75 south to I-696 east. Exit at Van Dyke and turn north (left).

From the South (downtown Detroit): Take I-75 north to I-696 east. Exit at Van Dyke and turn north (left).

The Vehicle Engineering Center (VEC) Building is located on the GM Technical Center Campus at the corner of Van Dyke and 12 mile in Warren, MI. Once on Van Dyke Avenue, continue about 1 mile. Turn left at the first entrance to the GM Tech. center, which is just past 12 mile road. Stop at the guard post to obtain a Visitor Pass. The VEC building will be directly in front of you. Visitor parking is available to the right with additional parking to the left between the building and Van Dyke Avenue.
