Exit at the 12th Street/Oakland City Center station. Look for the APL building when you exit the station on Broadway.

Directions

From San Francisco:

Take the Bay Bridge to 580 toward Hayward. Merge onto 980 W. toward downtown Oakland. Take the 12th St. exit. Make a left onto 11th St.

From Highway 24:

From 24 merge onto 980 W. toward downtown Oakland. Take the 12th St. exit. Make a left onto 11th St.

From South 880:

Take 880 N. Take the Broadway exit. Turn right onto Broadway. Turn left onto 10th St. Turn

right onto Clay St. Turn right onto 11th St.

From East 580:

Take 580 W. toward San Francisco. Merge onto 980 W. toward downtown Oakland. Take the 12th St. exit. Make a left onto 11th St.

The nearest parking garage is City Center Parking, with an entrance on the left side of 11th St. just after Clay St. There is free parking after 5:00 p.m.
