From 101 South:

Take 101 North towards San Francisco. Take the I-280 exit toward PORT of SF. Take the left ramp onto KING St. Turn left on 3RD ST. 3RD ST becomes KEARNY ST. Take a right on CLAY ST. The address is 424 CLAY ST.
