### **An evening about libraries, collegial interaction, and wine – what could be better!**

The Wine Institute is an advocacy and public policy association representing more than 1,000 wineries and affiliated businesses and works to create a positive environment for wine and the wine community. The Wine Institute was formed after Repeal in an effort to unify the industry against another Prohibition and also to work towards the industry's common goals.

The Wine Institute Library is a private library open to the Wine Institute staff, its members, and working members of the wine press by appointment. The collection consists of about 3,000 titles and also houses a 2,000 plus historical photo collection and archives on wine history, including: photographs, technical, legal, and marketing information from the beginning of the 20th century.

During the tour we'll have the opportunity to see the active collection space, view a few representative items from the archive, hear about their recent retrospective catalog conversion and creation of a photo database, and (of course) drink some wine graciously provided by the Institute.
