This past February, Nancy Zimmelman was appointed State Archivist by Secretary of State Bruce McPherson, and is the first woman to be State Archivist in California state history. She joined the California State Archives in 1987, and during her tenure she directed the California Legislative Archives Program and was responsible for the care of the Los Angeles Police Department's files of the investigation of Robert F. Kennedy's assassination. In addition to serving as State Archivist, Ms. Zimmelman serves on the Management Committee of the Western Archives Institute, and is active in development of the profession.

Ms. Zimmelman will provide insights about archives and archival practice, discuss the role and mission of the California State Archives, and offer advice for librarians in working with the archives. She'll also take your questions during what promises to be an informative and entertaining evening. We look forward to seeing you there.
