**Kalamarakia:** pan-fried lightly-breaded baby squid in lemon sauce

Shields Library, University of California, Davis is home to one of the finest collections of grape growing and wine making literature in the world. The collection is housed in the Maynard A. Amerine Viticulture & Enology Room on the third floor of Peter J. Shields Library, University of California, Davis. The collection gathers together materials on grape growing, grape diseases, wine making, fermentation science as well as the economic aspects of the wine industry. The primary emphasis is on the technical & scientific, historical and cultural aspects of grape growing and wine making with strong holdings in the economic and business aspects of grapes and wine.

### **Directions to Shields Library:**

After parking in lot 5, Walk to the NorthWest corner of the lot (East of Wyatt Pavilion) and cross Old Davis Road at the pedestrian walk. Continue north over the bridge over Putah Creek. Walk between Wright Hall/Main Theater and the Music building and turn left. Cross Hutchinson to walk along the South end of the Shields Library. Entrance is on the West end of the building and you enter through the automatic doors on the left.
