Volunteer Pool

SLA Toronto's Volunteer Pool is a group of dedicated volunteers who agree to be available for at least one discreet volunteer activity during the calendar year, e.g. to write articles for *The Courier* or assist with an event or short-term project. All members of the Volunteer Pool report to the Executive Board.

Expertise Pool

SLA Toronto's Expertise Pool is a group of experienced members who agree to be available to the current Executive Board for ad-hoc consultation.
